

Can express him/herself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in the most complex situations.

Can understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts. and recognise implicit meaning. Can express him/herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. Can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes. Can produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organisational patterns, connectors and cohesive devices.

Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialisation. Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party. Adult Group Courses in Gozo & Malta

Standard Group

General English Standard (20 lessons/max. 12 students)

This programme focuses on giving the learner **balanced** practice in both **systems** and **skills** using general topics. The course concentrates on all the four skills: **Speaking, Listening, Reading** and **Writing** with a special emphasis on fluency.

General English Intensive (30 lessons/max. 12 students)

Mini Group


Summative assessment and student counselling







Set in a safe area, our BELS Juniors residence/ hotel is located a few minutes away from the rocky beach and within walking distance of the main square in Buģibba. Accommodation is triple rooms. Some quadruple rooms may be used in the summer. All rooms are air-conditioned and include a ceiling fan, a balcony, an en-suite bathroom with shower, hairdryer, a television with basic reception service, a safety deposit box (at a nominal fee), and wi-fi. All BELS students can make use of the hotel's outdoor & indoor pools. BELS Staff will be living at the hotel to provide our students with round the clock customer care support and supervision. Accommodation is on full board, with buffet style meals (breakfast + lunch + dinner). In summer we provide a hot lunch. Water is included with the meals.
