



The room includes free WiFi, environmentally regulated air-conditioning or heating, bed linen, towels and cleaning thrice weekly or once for stays of more than 7 weeks, safety and security features.

Common accompanying facilities are daily cold continental buffet breakfast, free fresh cool mineral water, 24/7 reception and security service with CCTV cameras, coin operated food dispensers and washing machines for personal use.

Campus Residence is ideally located within a 2 minute walk to the University, 15 minute to the NSTS-English Language Institute and public transport stations to all important destinations including the airport, and to the numerous low-cost eateries and open-air bars along the Gzira-Sliema scenic harbour waterfront on the way to the Sliema commercial centre. The entertainment spot of St. Julian's is within 30 minutes' reach.

You will be accommodated in alternative rooms as available in self-catering apartments at no additional charge if Campus Residence is full during your proposed stay.

You are at least a 17-year-old vocational or academic student with a good CEFR A2 level of English, or a graduate at B1 level, to maximise your interaction and skills development during your internship. If not, you may better undertake a preparatory 2-week course in General English (see page 7).

You will forward us your CV and motivation letter and discuss these virtually with your NSTS Monitor to ensure a most suitable placement. On your first day you will receive an orientation and be accompanied and introduced to your internship Mentor. You will contribute up to 35 hours of internship service every week.

Your NSTS Monitor will meet with you regularly and support you as necessary throughout your stay. You will reciprocate respect, friendship, and exemplary demeanour consistent with the purpose of your learning objective in Malta.

You would live in a shared room in a student residence or apartment on self-catering or you may opt for a single room. Your airport arrival welcome, return and first placement-day transfers are all included. You must provide for your own daily transport, meals and incidentals.



# High School & Senior High School / 01st January 2023 - 29th June 2024

Malta combines the British System of Education with the advantages of the European Union, set within an English-speaking cosmopolitan society of hospitable and friendly people in the warm Mediterranean.

Malta is well known for its robust British system of education delivered in partner private schools that welcome foreign students to provide an intercultural enrichment in the class and promote European integration.

At the age of 13 to 15 years you will receive all-round learning in English and another European language, in mathematics, the humanities, sciences, and physical and social education by attending the High/Secondary School local grades 9, 10 or 11 that lead to the GCSE 'O' levels and completion of compulsory education.

If you are aged 16 to 18 years, you follow the Senior High School local grades 12 or 13 which lead to the international British GCSE Advanced 'A' level examinations that are recognised by English-speaking Universities world-wide. Your studies will be chosen from a list to include 2 subjects at 'A' level, 3 at Intermediate level, and Systems of Knowledge.

To join you will first introduce yourself, your motivations and knowledge of English during a virtual meeting with the NSTS Guardian and a teacher of English prior to registering for a year, semester or term.

Once accepted you are welcomed by on-going Guardianship support, care, extra-curricular school activities, motivating debates, friendly reunions, and opportunities for optional sports, fun and entertainment.

The fees cover tuition, a shared room on full board at a host family, arrival orientation, on-going Guardianship support, organised activities, and airport transfers.

Fees do not include the virtual meeting, schoolbooks, outings and High/Secondary School uniform, insurance, public transport, and incidentals.





By submitting your application, you bind yourself to these terms and conditions.

- 1. **Applications**: Completed applications in English will be received via e-mail on reservations@nsts.org or online on www.nstsmalta.org at the latest:
  - (i) English Language Learning: 4 weeks before the selected arrival date if part of a group or arriving between 10 June and 25 August. Or 2 weeks if an individual arriving before or after this period;
  - (ii) **Study Abroad:** 21 weeks (5 months) before the selected arrival date, including virtual contact address for online introductory chat. Registration follows the chat;
  - (iii) **Internships:** 10 weeks before the selected arrival date, including CV, motivation letter, and virtual contact address for online introductory chat;
